## **Judgment & Justice For The Glory of God**

Amos 3:1-8, 11; 4:2, 6-13

**Big Idea:** God punishes his people when they abandon holiness.

- The way Israel abandoned holiness in Amos is through their actions of social injustice.
- God calls for holiness to be portrayed through His people so that the world will see it and glorify the name of the Lord.

**Point 1:** God punishes His chosen people when they sin for a specific purpose. (Amos 3:1-2)

**Point 2:** God orchestrates disaster and sometimes uses it for judgment. (Amos 3:3-8)

**Point 3:** God punishes to redirect His people to honor and see His glory. (Amos 4:6-13)

*Are you displaying God's holiness in your life so others can see the glory of God?*

**Challenge of the Week:** Ask others that know you well how they can see and therefore learn more about God's character through you. Then ask them in what ways you fail often in displaying God's character in your life.
