Thankfully the highs during the day in the sunshine are mid 60s, but often the buildings are considerably colder than the outside temperature. In October, I started to have issues with the AC unit in my living room (it dripped water inside) and I was told that it needed to be cleaned out before I could use it again. The AC unit has the ability to produce hot air, but I was hesitant to try it after my experience with water pouring from the unit into my living room. Through a series of events, a friend explained to me that it might not drip water when producing hot air, and that I should try it to see. This has made the living room much more enjoyable and I have a small portable heater that I am able to use in other spaces around the apartment.
