I was invited to Salma's house on Sunday evening for iftar - the evening meal where they break the fast. It was a very sweet time together with her and her 3 kids. She had prepared a meal of soup, breads, dates, cheese and crepes made by her daughters. I loved asking questions, listening and learning about her life and culture. She explained things that she likes about Ramadan and things that are hard for her. When she learned that it was my first time having iftar, she felt very honored that I experienced it with her and her family. At one point she mentioned my religion and how me and Pedro's family are different from others. I explained that we don't have a religion, but we have a relationship with God and God has given us love for her and others. We laughed together as she jokingly shared that her youngest daughter (who is 8 years old) eats breakfast then does Ramadan, then eats lunch then does Ramadan, then breaks the fast with the rest of the family at 9pm. :-) I am so thankful for this precious family and the time we can spend together. Please keep praying for them to one day experience a relationship with God through the sacrifice of Christ.
