Many local artists give flamenco style performances. It is definitely a cultural event and I am learning a lot!

This week, I called my friend Salma to tell her about our women's event on May 27th. In our conversation, she told me that her refrigerator had broken and there were other issues in her kitchen that needed immediate attention. She is a single mom of 3 and I could tell that she was stressed and overwhelmed. She said that many of her friends and family were contributing to help her with these unexpected costs. After ending our conversation, I wanted to help too and began to pray about the best way. After speaking with Pedro and Elsa, we gave her a financial contribution toward her housing costs from all of us. She called me afterward and was so very appreciative. She said that the amount we gave was exactly the amount that she still needed to purchase a new refrigerator. She said it was "luck." I shared gently that I don't believe it was luck but that it was God who knew exactly what she needed and lovingly provided for her. Praise God for the opportunity to serve this sweet friend.
