CHURCH BYLAWS (ON DEACON QUALIFICATIONS)

The deacons shall be ministering servants of the Church (Acts 6:1-3). They shall assist the pastors and the staff in the ministry of the FBC Springfield. By their behavior and their words, they shall promote a harmonious fellowship among the members. The primary qualifications of a deacon shall be those listed in Acts 6:1-8 and 1 Timothy 3:8-13. Candidates for deacon should have proven themselves to be a follower of Jesus Christ by their behavior, words, and deeds within the church, their homes, and community. They shall be at least 21 years old and have been a member of FBC Springfield for a year. A deacon may be married or single. Deacons shall cheerfully and regularly contribute to the financial support of FBC Springfield's ministries.
