Thank you so much for praying for the medical missions trip to North Africa. It was quite a week! I will be honest in saying by human standards, it was a total flop. There was confusion/opposition/difficulty with the permissions which resulted in 18 health care professionals sitting in a hotel in a remote area of great need, down the road from a hospital which functions at about 1/4th of its capacity, with strong desires to serve but an inability to do so. It is easy to look at the situation and think, "What a waste! What was the purpose of that? Where were you, God?"

I trust the truth we learn in Isaiah 55:8-9, "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord.
