OUR BELIEF

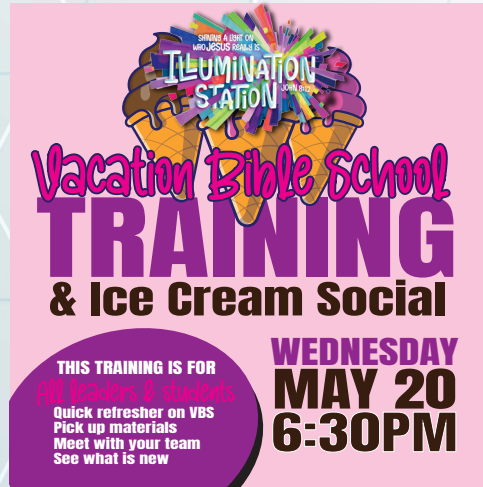
