TUESDAY | Jesus Is God's Perfect Son

"He has done everything well..." – Mark 7:37

Pray that the children see Jesus as the ultimate helper and friend, the only One who is completely good all the time.

WEDNESDAY | Jesus Is the Powerful Son of God

"Even the wind and the waves obey him!" – Mark 4:41

When they hear the story of Jesus calming the storm, pray they understand that Jesus is stronger than anything that scares them. Pray they learn to say, "Jesus is strong, so I don't have to be afraid."

THURSDAY | Jesus Is the Proven Son of God

"He is not here; he has risen!" – Luke 24:6

Pray for the teachers to use simple, powerful words to explain that Jesus died but came back to life because He is God's alive Son.

FRIDAY | Jesus Is God's Plan for Forgiveness

"Be kind to one another... forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you." – Ephesians 4:32

Pray that as they learn about God's big forgiveness, they grasp the basic concept of the Gospel: when we make wrong choices (sin), Jesus loves us enough to forgive us and clean our hearts.
