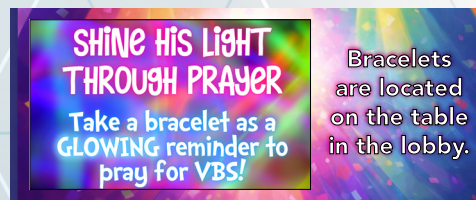
Pray for our 7th - 12th grade students as they head off to MFuge Camp, to serve the Lord and study His Word.
