OUR BELIEF

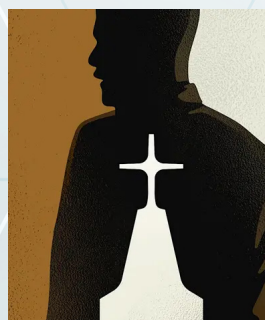
